Nothing should be done at all to the Stop Shop main entrance, nor to the Grant Road entrance. There is nothing whatsoever wrong with these, and redevelopment would be a total waste of money.

However at least one lift and escalator should be installed from the subway to at least one of the platforms, so people with luggage, pushchairs and in wheelchairs can have step-free access to all platforms via the lifts/footbridge. The new entrance at Brighton Yard is really inaccessible to wheelchairs, etc. because it is at the top of a hill.
