Hi guys

Got your flyer through. In response to your bullet points:

- The station could make a landmark building that should blend in with surroundings but be more accessible (think this is in progress)
- Tall buildings - I would say no higher than the PCS building which is quite dominating.
- Entrance at Grant Street - More space for purchasing tickets and an area that is fit-for-purpose rather than 'a channel' for loads of people queing for tickets
- Shopping - I think that there should be the same size shops but perhaps more of them if it will contribute towards paying towards the development
- Access - Not sure what can be done here unless a dedicated area for taxis/disabled people is created
- It would be nice if a redevelopment could include some sort of features or dare I say it green areas as the station area does come across as very grey and drab. Perhaps a statue or water feature or something that symbolises Battersea
